ABOUT THE COURSE

Research grants can support ongoing studies or enable the initiation of new research in a particular field. Research covers a wide range of subjects, including literature, medicine, and environmental studies. These grants are offered by different organizations to assist individuals, universities, and other groups in funding their research endeavors. The funding may either be open-ended or limited to cover specific living expenses, depending on the grant's guidelines.

The purpose of this workshop is to offer a detailed, step-by-step guide to the process of applying for research funding. It will be particularly beneficial for either a new academic looking to join a research group or a young clinician seeking to establish their own research endeavors. We provide instructions on composing each section of the proposal and walk through the stages of preparation, writing, and submission of an application. The workshop also includes information about the different types of funding options, guidance on selecting the appropriate funding organization, a discussion on the various individuals who should be involved in developing the research proposal, and details about the available sources of support to assist the new researcher in advancing their ideas.
