## ABOUT THE COURSE

Research grants can be applied to research that is already taking place or pave the way for completely new research in a field. Research can encompass many subjects, such as literature, medicine, and the environment. Research grants are made available by various institutions to help fund research efforts made by individuals, universities, and other groups. The money can be unrestricted or allow only for a certain amount to cover living expenses. It all depends on the guidelines of the grant. Aim of the workbook is to provide a step-by-step overview of the process of applying for research funding and will be most relevant to either a new academic joining a group or a young clinician wanting to establish their own research. We explain how to write each component of the proposal and cover the steps involved in preparing, writing and submitting an application. Included is a description of the different types of funding available, how to choose the right funding body, a discussion of the various people who should be involved in developing the research proposal and the sources of support available to help the new researcher take their ideas forward.
